

MCHD Capital Campaign Building Project Information

- **What's the plan?**
 - Construction of new inpatient wing, medical office facilities on Mildred road campus, upgrades to Emergency Department, and EMS station
 - 3 year anticipated completion if project breaks ground in spring 2016.
- **Funding**
 - Limited sales tax initiative of .40% in Montezuma County, or 4 cents on every \$10 spent to be decided by **mail-in ballot on November 3, 2015**
 - A variety of grants to help contribute to the total cost
- **Project Details**
 - **New inpatient wing to replace current facility in need of repair and renovation**
 - Nurses and hospitalists will have a closer eye on all patients and easier access based on new floor plan
 - Increase comfort, safety and privacy for patients and visitors
 - **Build medical office facilities on-campus at Mildred Road Location to improve continuum and coordination of care**
 - Increase access to primary care providers and specialists with aggressive recruitment
 - Cardiology
 - Oncology
 - Nephrology
 - Urology
 - ENT
 - General Surgery
 - Internal Medicine
 - Family Medicine with OB Privileges
 - On-site laboratory and imaging for patients
 - Eliminate confusion by offering a centralized location for patients, improved signage, and better flow for office visits
 - **EMS Station**
 - Increase the effective life of our ambulances, ambulance equipment and supplies
 - Prevent weather related damage to equipment and medication
 - Provide sleep facility for 24 hour shift employees
- **Why should I care about this project?**
 - We cannot shut down hospital during renovation- a new patient wing built outside the current footprint would minimize disruptions to patients and staff during construction while maintaining state regulations for patient care and safety
 - SHS will take every step to make sure that patients do not have to travel outside of Montezuma County for healthcare by providing excellent providers, services and facilities that meet the needs of our community
- **Construction**
 - Nunn Construction will serve as construction Manager and Ralph Wegner will serve as owners representative and will work diligently to use local subcontractors whenever possible.
